#### Driving Directions to Valley Medical Center (see maps)

Driving north or south on I-5, take the northbound I-405 exit. At Renton, take the southbound Hwy 167 (Kent/Auburn) exit.

From 167 southbound, take the first exit, South 180th. Off the exit, turn left at the signal on East Valley Rd, then turn left at the next light, heading east on SW 43rd Street.

From 167 northbound, take the 43rd Street exit. Turn right off the exit onto 43rd Street South. To reach the main entrance, turn left at Talbot Road South, then left again onto the campus

#### Valley Parking

Parking is free at Valley

Park in North Parking Garage, located just north of the campus across from the Medical Arts Center (MAC) building. Will need to park on the 4<sup>th</sup> level or above. —follow signs to Hospital. **Do not park in the Main parking lot.** 

#### **Storeroom/Equipment location**

Equipment location: on 3W Infusion Center, to the left behind nurse station across from room 320. Equipment location. Key Box code is 3045

Supply location: on 3N, room 3729 near treatment room. Need key from Nursing station. Treatment area—Located on 3N---See Treatment Area Guidelines

#### Orders/Medications/Documentation:

Orders: MD writes orders within EPIC for HD, PD, CRRT, TPE. **Meds:** Heparin and Lidocaine 1% in Pyxis for dialysis. No medications are to be kept in supply carts. — **DOH violation if found!!!** 

**Treatment documentation:** All Charting done within EPIC –See EPIC reference guides

Locations: Plumbed rooms -3C, 3D, 3E, 3 SCU. Hook up to sink on NWA, NWB, & 2W. Use backflow prevention valves for all treatments.

  - Oncology—3 East —3<sup>rd</sup> floor—by cafeteria
  - Renal/Medical—3 N—3<sup>rd</sup> floor
  - CCU—4 south—4<sup>th</sup> floor tower

  - Spine—5 south—5<sup>th</sup> floor tower
  - Joint/Ortho—5 south—5<sup>th</sup> floor tower
  - Cardiology/Telemetry—6 south—6<sup>th</sup> floor tower
    Neurology— 6 south—6<sup>th</sup> floor tower

  - Surgery—7 south—7<sup>th</sup> floor tower



6 and 7 South each have a water box key attached to an F5 dialyzer. You can get it from the HUC, please return it to the HUC after your treatment

Charge slips – Charges done within EPIC under Charge Capture. Fill out paper Cost Sheet and Fax to HS office, Place Cost sheet in the office bin by the storeroom.

- 6 and 7 South Tower have a different box so you don't need the quick disconnect fittings like on 4 and 5





## Sink with no dialysis water connection





