

# CARECOMPASS QUICK GUIDE

## NAVIGATING CARECOMPASS

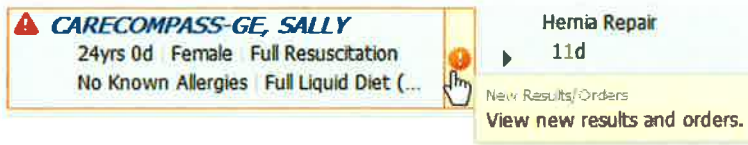
- Location:** Shows room and bed assignments (e.g., 1058-01, 1059-01).
- Patient:** Lists patient names (e.g., CARECOMPASS-GE, SALLY) and demographic information (age, gender, allergies, diet).
- Visit:** Shows the patient's current visit (e.g., Hernia Repair 2d, abdominal pain 4d).
- Care Team:** Lists the attending physician (e.g., Biehl MD, Thomas).
- Result Columns:** Displays vital signs: Temperature (38), Systolic Blood Pressure (110), Heart Rate (140), Oxygen Saturation (90), and Glucose (200).
- Activities:** Shows the number of tasks (e.g., 7, 23) and a PRN button.
- Activity Timeline:** A horizontal bar chart at the bottom showing scheduled and overdue tasks over a 24-hour period.

- Information Bar:** Includes **Patient List** options on the left; on the right a **New Results/Orders** icon will display with a count of new orders or results as follows:
  - New **abnormal** results and/or **new orders** are present for any of the patients.
  - New **critical results** or **stat orders** are present for any of the patients.
  - The **New Results/Orders** indicator will also display next to the patient's name.
- Location:** Room and bed assignment; when **Infection Control Precautions** are ordered, the **Isolation** icon displays. **Hover** over the **Isolation** icon to see the precautions orders/details.
- Patient:** Patient name, demographics and allergy information. **Hover** over the patient name or allergies to view additional information. **Single click** the patient name to open their chart.
  - The High Risk indicator will display when the following has been ordered or documented:**
    - Delirium Risk:**
      - CAM/ICU CAM = *Positive for delirium*
      - Overall CAM-ICU Score = *Positive for delirium*
      - Admission & History PowerForm: *Documented at Risk, Hx Cognitive and/or Hx Delirium*
    - Constant Care Companion: Order**
    - Fall Risk:** Fall Risk Pre-screen: *Patient has experienced a fall during hospitalization.*
    - Restraints:** *Violent/Self-Destructive Restraint & Renew Restraints Orders*
    - Skin Breakdown/Pressure Ulcer:** *Braden Score of < 16 and/or Pressure Ulcer > any stage*
    - CIWA Assessments:** *ETOH Withdrawal Screen Score > 8 and/or ETOH Withdrawal Screen order*
- Visit:** **Chief Complaint** (from Admission Hx form or ED Triage form) and length of stay.
- Care Team:** **Attending Physician**
- Result Columns:** **Temperature, Systolic Blood Pressure, Peripheral Pulse Rate, Oxygen Saturation, Glucose.**
- Activities (Tasks):** Number of **Medications, Patient Care, Assessment, Other** tasks.
  - Hover** to see the breakdown of tasks within each category and number of overdue tasks in **red**.
  - Click **PRN** button to view the **PRN/Continuous** tasks.
- Activity Timeline:** Graphic representation of scheduled and overdue tasks for all patients on your patient list. This section can be collapsed or expanded.

## REVIEWING RESULTS & ORDERS

To review orders:

1. Click the **New Results/Orders** indicator next to a patient name.

2. Click the **New Results/Orders** icon on the **Information Bar** at the top right of the **CareCompass** and select a patient.



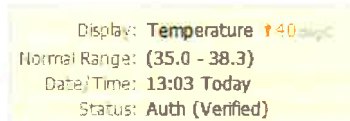
3. The **Items for Review** window will open; if **results** are available they will show on the left, **orders** on the right.
  - **Results and Orders** are all preselected; unselect any you do not want to review at this time.
  - **Stat Orders** will appear with red text.

Hover over order details to see additional order information.

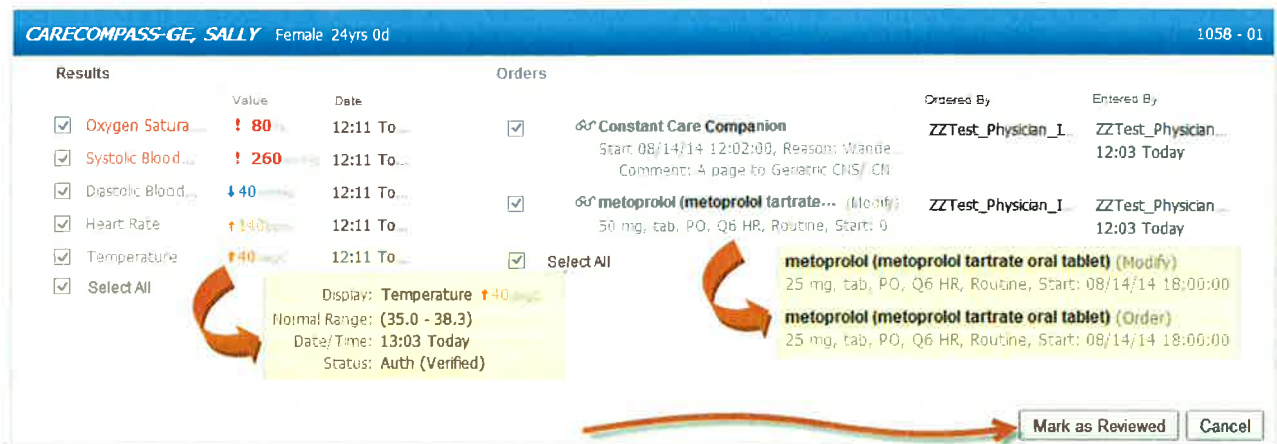


- **Below normal** results will appear in **blue** with a down arrow.
- **Above normal** results will appear in **orange** with an up arrow.
- **Critical Results** will appear in **red** with an exclamation point.

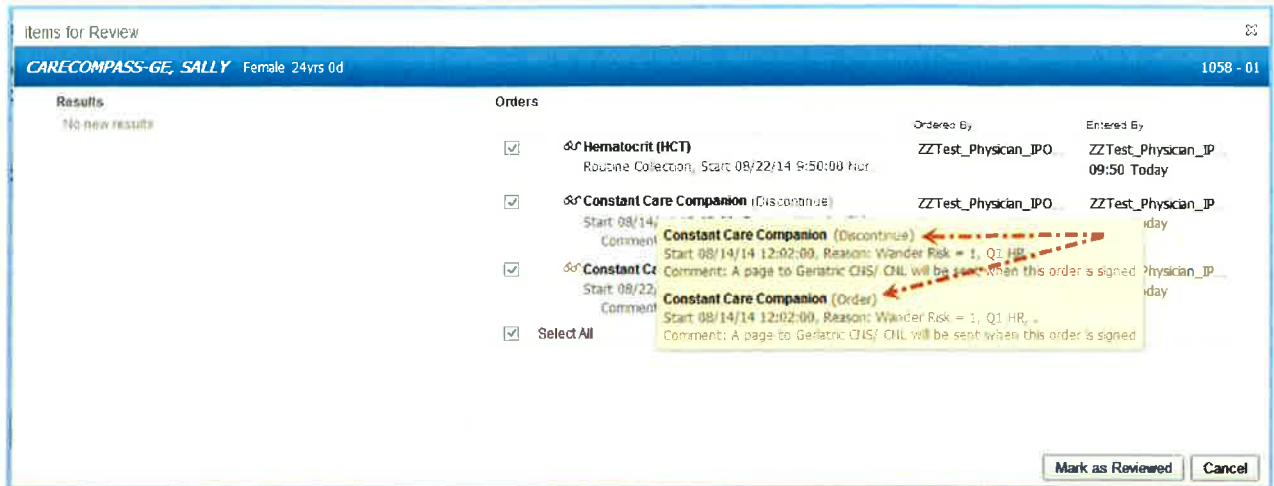
Hover over any result to view additional details.



4. Click the **Mark as Reviewed** button to clear the selected items.



- In the **Items for Review** window, when you *hover* over an order that has been **modified** or **discontinued**, the modified or discontinued order will display at the top with the previous order below.

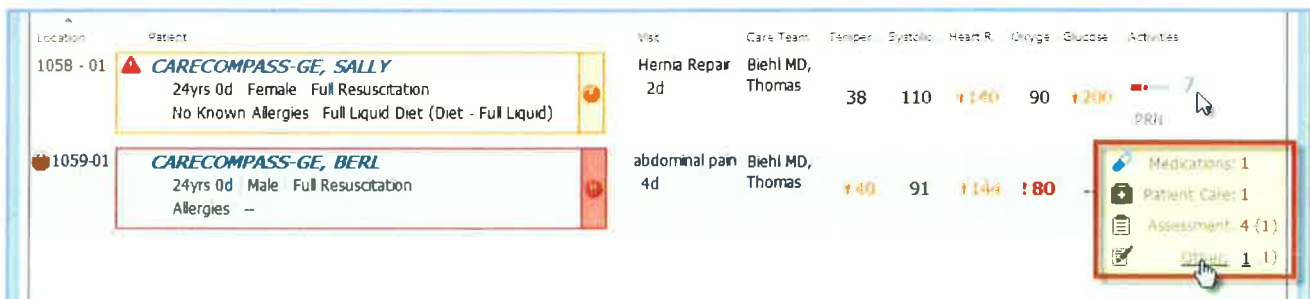


## ACTIVITIES (TASKS)

### Accessing and Documenting Activities (Tasks):

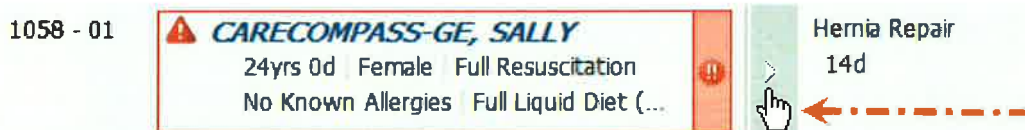
#### I. Activities column:

- The **Activities** column displays the number of activities (tasks) due and includes a colored bar to indicate **STAT**, **Overdue** & **Current** tasks.
- Hover* on the number displayed to view a breakdown of the number tasks due in each category: **Medication**, **Patient Care**, **Assessment** and **Other**. It will also display the number of any **STAT/Overdue** tasks in parentheses.
- Hover* and then *click* on one of the task types to access those tasks.
- Click* on the **PRN** button to access **PRN/Continuous** tasks.



#### II. From the Patient column:

- Hover* and then *click* when the arrow appears to open the **Activities** window to access all activities for the patient.







## Activities (Tasks) Window

### 1. Demographic Banner

### 2. Tabs





- Activities** tab shows scheduled and unscheduled tasks.
- PRN/Continuous** tab shows any PRN and/or Continuous tasks.
- Patient Information** displays room/bed, Attending, High Risk indicators, Allergies, Visit Reason, etc.

### 3. Activities Display filters: *Click* once to filter, *click* again to remove the filter.

-  Medication Activities Displayed
-  Patient Care Activities Displayed
-  Assessment Activities Displayed
-  Other (Transfer) Activities Displayed

### 4. Time Frame Selection buttons can be used to view future tasks up to 12 hours.

## Activities (Tasks) Facts & Functionality

-  **STAT** and **overdue tasks** sort to the top of the **Activities** window.
-  **Medication tasks** cannot be documented in the **Activities** window.
-  **Hover** over **NURSE COLLECT TASKS** to view specimen container details.
-  “Like” tasks (from same category- e.g. *Assessment Activities*) can be multi-selected by using a single click on each and then marked as **Done**, **Not Done** or **Document**. If tasks that are not “like” are selected at the same time, the buttons will not be available.

## Charting Activities (Tasks)

1. Click on an **Activity (task)** to select it.  
**Tip:** You may select "like" activities (tasks) to chart at the same time by *clicking* on those task(s).
2. Click on the appropriate button at the bottom right ~ **Done Not Done Document**.



3. Selecting the **Document** button will open up a corresponding **PowerForm**.
4. Selecting **Not Done** will open up a dialog box with a required **Reason Not Done** drop down selection field; additional comments can be added.

3. The corresponding **PowerForm** or **Not Done** dialog box will open.
4. Complete any required fields and then click the **Sign Form** button to complete the charting.

## Documenting Nurse Collect Lab Activities (Tasks)

1. Click on an the Nurse Collect **Activity (task)** to select it.
2. Click on the appropriate button at the bottom right ~ **Done Not Done** .
3. Charting **Done** will automatically generate a printed requisition for the specimen.

### Right Click option:

1. **Right click** on the activity (task) to be charted.
2. Select the appropriate action offered on the shortcut menu ,
