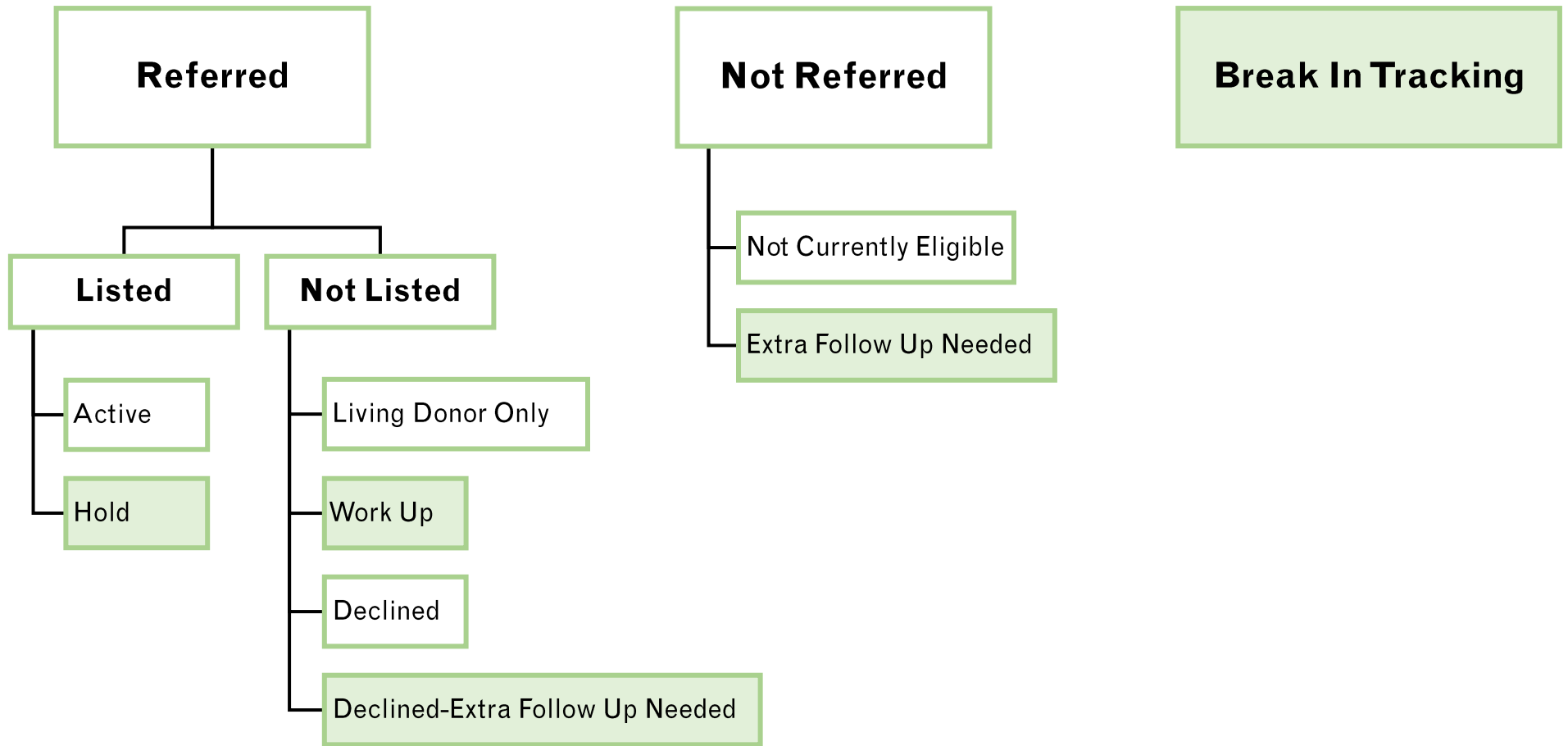


Transplant Status

Transplant Status Explanations

Referred— Listed	Active Patient-active on one or more UNOS transplant list
	Hold Patient is on hold on one or more UNOS transplant list (also known as inactive or UNOS Status 7)
Referred— Not Listed	Living Donor Only Per transplant program, patient is only able to be transplanted if a living donor is approved; NOT eligible for a deceased donor transplant
	Work-up Per the transplant program, patient is completing evaluation
	Declined Was referred to at least one transplant program and turned down due to one or more of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Incurable cancer, severe CVD, untreatable systemic infection, dementia, inability to obtain informed consent – Lack of follow up by patient – Non-adherence; tobacco, MJ smoking or IV drug use; BMI; long term care facility; lack of social support, housing, or insurance coverage for transplant AND per SW/IDT assessment, is not making progress toward resolution
	Declined, extra follow-up needed <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Patient was referred to at least one transplant program. Most recent referral resulted in patient being turned down for transplant. However, patient: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Has a treatable medical condition – Is actively working (per SW/IDT assessment) toward resolution of: non-adherence; tobacco, MJ smoking or IV drug use; BMI; long term care facility; lack of social support, housing, or insurance coverage for transplant • Patient declines to pursue current referral

Not Referred	Not referred, not currently eligible Patient has not been referred for transplant <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Patient has strong contraindications to transplant (see Referred Not Listed—Declined) – Patient has no interest in transplant despite having adequate information (per SW/IDT assessment)
	Not referred, extra follow up needed Patient has not been referred for transplant due to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Mild to moderate contraindications (see Referred Not Listed—Declined, extra follow-up needed) – MD doing testing pre-referral – Patient may lack adequate information about transplant (per SW/IDT assessment) – Eligible and interested in transplant – Reason not known by IDT
Break in Tracking	Break in tracking Patient has received a transplant or transferred out of NKC and then returns to dialysis at NKC. Previous EMR transplant status may not be accurate.
