

Clarity Monthly Update

General Information

The 3rd Sunday of every month Visonex updates Clarity with fixes to issues reported and enhancements based on client feedback. Following is a general overview of those fixes and enhancements that occurred on January 18, 2020

What's Fixed in Clarity

- When an immunization is given in RTC or Visit Management and the treatment is posted, it will automatically change the status of the immunization entry in Patient>Immunizations from "Scheduled in Clinic" to "Administered in Clinic." The nurse will still need to return to the entry to add the Lot # and Exp Date of the vaccine.
- 2. The Percent PTH Change (PPC) formula in Clarity's Medication Management decision support tool is now correct. [(Current iPTH-Previous iPTH)/Previous iPTH] x 100.
- 3. **New Reason for Missed Treatments**: You can now choose "Called and Cancelled" as a reason for a missed treatment.
- 4. **Network Event-Transfer to Extension Clinic-Update CrownWeb data check:** an existing CrownWeb data check has been updated to more easily allow internal transfers among units with the same NRAA number. The Clarity Network Event called NEUTRAL:Transfer to extension clinic was intended to allow these transfers, but sometimes would incorrectly trigger a data check error. This issue has been resolved.

What's New in Clarity

- 1. **Disable Add button on Medications so user cannot click multiple times**: An enhancement has been done on the Medication form. You will see the Add button is now disabled after it is clicked one time. This will prevent users from clicking the Add button multiple times in a row which was creating duplicate medication orders.
- 2. Add Order Method to "Dialysis Prescription Order History" report: Users may find this report helpful when submitting reports to support CMS CERT requests.



3. Tip: How to prevent a nurse or MD from getting an E-signature request for a discontinued order: When discontinuing the order, do not use the End Now button. If you use the End Now button it associates the Order Taken By staff and the Ordered By physician involved in the creation of the order being discontinued. Do use the Change Order button and enter the end date. When you use the Change Order button, it lets Clarity know you are creating a new order and it will send the E-signature request only to the Order Taken By staff and the Ordered By physician for this new order.
