

Clarity Tips & Tricks – Week 1

- When printing **Medication Labels**, select **Viewer** for the **Output Type** (instead of PDF)
 - $\circ~$ The alignment at the bottom of the page might be off it you leave it as PDF

- If you need to reset/re-enter the Patient ID in the **BBraun** machine:
 - Unclick the Start Time from the Pre Treatment tab in Real-Time Charting
 - Click on the **Red Man** on the BBraun
 - Enter the Patient ID #
 - Click on the Green Man on the BBraun
 - Click on **Start Time** on the Pre Treatment screen and enter actual start time
- Total Treatment Time on the Post Treatment tab is in minutes
 - Do NOT change this time to hours—it will create treatment variance errors
- Medication Tips:
 - $\circ~$ Most meds that are administered on dialysis should be ordered 3x/week (In-Center)
 - Mircera and Zemplar (for In-Center) need to be ordered On Selected Days (frequency)
 - If a Mircera or Zemplar dose is not given, the order needs to be adjusted for a new date. (New tasks will not generate from "Not Given")
 - **PRN Orders** are "one and done" for the run. But they will show up in all visits if they are entered with a frequency of **3x/week** (for In-Center).
 - Adm Type drives where a medication shows up"
 - Adm on Dialysis (In-Center—RTC)
 - Self Adm on Dialysis (Home Hemo)
 - Facility Adm (Clinic Visits, Home Program)



- Bulk Adm (do not use)
- Leave blank when entering home meds

• Medications will need to be moved with schedule changes

- You will get a popup to address medications scheduled for "on selected days"
- Use dose counter for time limited medications rather than date range
 - This is a better option in case patient misses runs
- Finding Patient Information
 - **Medicaid #s**: Registration > Insurance Information > Policies
 - **MD phone #s**: Organization > Physicians
 - **Nursing home addresses**: Organization > Nursing Homes

• Patient Chart View

- Review labs—there is no acknowledge button
- Review treatment history—can see accesses used
- Review medications
