

Entering Hospitalizations in Clarity

Hospitalizations will begin populating Clarity 8/12/19. We will continue to receive faxes from EDIE/PreManage until the end of September. The only hospitalizations that will need to be entered manually are hospitalizations that occur out-of-state. The instructions below list the steps to document the hospitalization information in Clarity.

You will see the following pop-up when you submit the form.



When you click "OK", it does NOT remove their entire schedule, just the timeframe of the hospitalization.

KEY POINTS ABOUT DOCUMENTING HOSPITALIZATIONS

- Whenever this form is opened and <u>you add any documentation</u>, the "Add to Patient's Current Problem List" will default as checked, and you will need to uncheck it before submitting the form.
 - This is true even for the hospitalizations that are auto-populated
- When a discharge date is entered, the length of stay (LOS) will autocalculate.
 - LOS auto-calculates based on the calendar day, so stays that occur over midnight (but are less than 24 hours) will show as 1
- The Inpatient Status always defaults to "Inpatient". The "Type of Visit" is where you indicate an Emergency Department visit.
- BE SURE TO ENTER A MISSED TREATMENT IF YOUR PATIENT MISSES
 A RUN
- Clinics should run the "Clinic Hospitalizations Short Form" to track hospitalizations
- Hospitalizations that auto-populate that result in an inpatient admission need to have the form updated with:
 - "Sent" or "Not Sent to Hospital Directly from Dialysis Facility"
 - "No" for Will the patient be dialyzed at this clinic while their status is Inpatient?
