

Clarity Monthly Update-February

General Information

The 3rd Sunday of every month Visonex updates Clarity with fixes to issues reported and enhancements based on client feedback. This month the update took place sooner than usual on Sunday, February 9, 2020. Following is a general overview of those fixes and enhancements.

What's Fixed in Clarity

- 1. From **Patient > Patient Chart View** you should now be able to click on the following tabs without getting an error message:
 - a. Report tab
 - b. Access tab
- 2. From **Treatment > Primary Nephrologist Dashboard**, clicking on the "**Open PCV**" link will open that patient's Patient Chart View screen.
- 3. **Vancomycin and Daptomycin** orders no longer default to ESRD Related = Yes. Please click ESRD Related = No for non ESRD-Related diagnoses.

What's New in Clarity

- Medication Reconciliation. The Patient > Patient Assessment dropdown now includes an assessment titled Medication Reconciliation. At the bottom of the assessment the user will be able to select their role in the "Medication Reconciled by" field.
 - a. "Care Manager: Medication Reconciliation" assessment is not to be used beginning February 9, 2020
 - b. "Pharmacist: Medication Reconciliation" assessment is not to be used beginning February 9, 2020
 - c. Please Do Not Use assessments that begin with "zDNU..." to create or document going forward. They are intended to allow you only to view assessments that existed prior to that date.
