

Clarity Monthly Update May 2021

General Information

The 3rd Sunday of every month Visonex updates Clarity with fixes to issues reported and enhancements based on client feedback. Following is a general overview of those fixes and enhancements that occurred on Sunday May 16, 2021.

What's Fixed in Clarity

- In Dialysis Prescriptions and Medication Orders, when the Justification Add to Patient's Current Problem List box is checked, Problems were not showing in Reports that are supposed to show patient Problem Lists. To resolve this issue, putting a Checkmark in Medication and Dialysis Prescription detail will now create a Problem List item in which Display on Report will be check-marked by default.
- 2. The **Cause of Renal Failure in 2728** was not showing in Reports. This was fixed and all previous 2728 were addressed to properly display in reports and checklists.
- 3. Staff should no longer get an **internal system error** when attempting to post an RTC treatment when the Medication tab was never opened.
- 4. Regarding **Immunization**:
 - a. In **Real-Time Charting**, **Immunizations** now correctly display in the **Medication/Imn** Tab
 - b. Migration Immunization Statuses: some Immunization records that existed prior to last month's data migration still showed "Posted" or "Allergy" and have been corrected.
 - c. QMAT ADW Immunization tab has been updated to reflect changes made in **Immunizations**



d. To meet CEHRT requirements and state immunization systems, Immunizations Documentation Section now has an NDC Code dropdown that is populated when the Vaccine is select. Staff can select the NDC code or 'Not Available' in the dropdown.

e. A specific **Immunization** group can now be selected when requesting creation of a Custom Report.

What's New in Clarity

- 1. In **Real-Time Charting**, an **asterisk** ("*") now appears for each item that is required in order to successfully post a treatment.
- PPD test administrations and readings are now to be documented in Patient>Test & Procedures. Add a Treatment Alert to schedule a future administration or reading.
