

Clarity Monthly Update July 2021

General Information


The 3rd Sunday of every month Visonex updates Clarity with fixes to issues reported and enhancements based on client feedback. Following is a general overview of those fixes and enhancements that occurred on Sunday July 18, 2021.

What's Fixed in Clarity

- 1. When adding a **Patient>Patient Infection** an incorrect message about the access would display inappropriately if a required field was missed. This is now fixed.
- 2. A bug that caused some text in the ***Patients with Infections* report** to be cut off has been fixed.
- 3. In **Patient>Patient Infection** the Fever>37.8C is no longer showing additional symbols.

What's New in Clarity

1. **Treatment Alerts Start Date** will now display at the beginning of each Alert. This will allow you to determine if the Alert is still valid or needs updating.



- When a patient schedule is updated, Last Given dates in Patient>Medication Management>Medications and in RTC Medications/Imn will appear in green until it is administered. It will become black once it is administered.
- 3. To add, update or end an **Infection** from **Real-Time Charting Nurse Assessment** Tab, users now need click the <u>Patient Infection</u> link in order to accommodate the following additional information in Patient Infection screens.



4. In **Patient>Patient Infection**, the **Recent Cultures** will now pull cultures within 15 days of the **Suspected Infection Start Date**.

- 5. A new *Clinic Tests & Procedures TB, PPD* Report lists OPEN tests, then COMPLETED test, then ACTIVE tests related to TB, PPD for the selected date range.
- 6. There is now an updated version of the Moderna Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) Fact Sheet given to Vaccine Recipients. In the RTC Medication/Imn tab, the Covid 19 Vaccine **Edition Date** has been updated to correspond to the most recent edition.
