

Clarity Monthly Update

September 2021

General Information

The 3rd Sunday of every month Visonex updates Clarity with fixes to issues reported and enhancements based on client feedback. Following is a general overview of those fixes and enhancements that occurred on Sunday, September 19, 2021.

What's Fixed in Clarity

1. The ***Patient Identification Numbers** clinic report now allows additional space so longer names will be properly visible.
2. The **RTC Hemodialysis Treatment Information** patient report was not completely displaying in Chrome and displayed HTML code. This is now corrected.
3. **Medication Management** will no longer round the **dose** to the next value when a decimal is included.
4. The **Blood Pressures Trends patient report** will now show a UFR value regardless of Treatment times or weight removed. Previously no UFR displayed for treatment times greater than 600 minutes or less than 60 minutes or for negative intra-dialysis weight removed.
5. Occasionally some users were not able to **access RTC Phy Rounding tab** when the patient had a medication on hold. This has been fixed.

What's New in Clarity

1. There is now a base Vaccine Formulary that will facilitate documentation in the **Immunization** screen. When you select a **Vaccine Group** the **Select Vaccine** button will list the appropriate vaccines that are available to the clinics. E.g., **Vaccine Group**= Hep B will display Engerix in the **Select Vaccine** button. To select a vaccine that is not available in the clinics, click the **Select Vaccine** button, click on the [Show Filters](#) link, uncheck the **Local Formulary** box, and click **Apply**.
 2. **Patient Synopsis Incenter patient report** – designed for providers, this
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report included current dialysis prescription, dialysis medications, immunizations, labs, and problem list. It can be accessed through **Treatments>Primary Nephrologist Dashboard** or **Reports>Report Wizard**.

3. Allergies are now in **Red** in the following areas:
 - a. **RTC tabs except** the Treatment Tab. Allergies are planned to be in bold red in the Treatment Tab with a future correction.
 - b. **Patient>Medication Management>Medications**



Patient Allergies: carvedilol - Unknown reaction., codeine - Dizziness, Latex -, Levaquin - Dizziness.



4. The **Patient>Medication Management>Medications** screen now has a medication Search field.
5. The most recent date for the Pfizer COVID Vaccine EUA was deployed in **Patient>Immunization**. The most recent date for the Moderna COVID Vaccine EUA is 8/27/2021. When documenting the Moderna EUA presentation to a patient, you can type "EAU Edition Date: 8/27/2021" in the **Notes** field in **RTC>Medications/Imn**. If you are documenting in **Patient>Immunization**, you can make the entry in the **Comments** field. 6. **RTC Header– Treatment Tab and Medication/Imn** now include date of birth, Code status, Birth Sex, Nephrologist and Allergies.
7. It is now possible to search **Patient>Notes** by **Date**.

State immunization programs and for Certified Electronic Health Record Technology (CEHRT) require a contact as "Next of Kin" for patients <19 years of age. When adding or updating a contact in **Registration>Patient Contact** for patients<19 years of age, a warning will display if Next of Kin has not yet been added. Ending a Next of Kin will also display a warning if a new Next of kin has not been identified.
