

Clarity Monthly Update June 2022

General Information

On a monthly basis Visonex updates Clarity with fixes to issues reported and enhancements based on client feedback. Following is a general overview of those fixes and enhancements that occurred on June 26, 2022.

What's Fixed in Clarity


- 1. **RTC Preference for Med and Tx tab not working** the preference for patient Birth Date Birth Sex, Code Status, and Primary Nephrologist to appear on the RTC Medication and Treatment Tabs were not working. These will be visible with the release.
- 2. The **E-signed Orders by Physician** report was not displaying the signer's title correctly. This is now corrected.
- 3. **Old open tasks** are no longer preventing users from logging into Clarity. This fix was released 5/19/2022.
- 4. **Open billing tasks** are no longer preventing users from logging in. This fix was released 6/7/2022.
- 5. **Medication End Now** staff were unable to end a Medication by selecting End Now. This fix was released 5/19/2022.
- 6. **On Hold medications not picking up end date** In RTC and Visit Management Medication/Imn tab the End Date was not displaying for On Hold Medications. This fix was released 5/19/2022.

What's New in Clarity

- 1. **Signing Ascend Orders** Physicians and providers can now sign unsigned Ascend lab orders by going to the Clarity Home Page and clicking on the unsigned orders notification link.
- 2. **CIA Splitter Authors** The Comprehensive Interdisciplinary Assessment will now include the name of each discipline author whose name is entered in the



'Reviewed By' field of the splitter.



- 3. Patient Chart View will now be accessed from the Main Menu.
- 4. **Medication Order Monthly Dose** will display two decimal places instead of one.
- 5. **Printing Visit Management** When printing directly from Visit Management page or when pulling Visit Management to a custom checklist report, dropdown values would display as numbers instead of the value selected. The values now display correctly.
- 6. *Home Treatments Open Report To assist with End of Month processes this report helps identify potential billing issues. The report pulls Visit Management treatments that have at least one, but not all tabs, posted. The report is intended to be run prior to the bill run day of each month.



7. **Medications Bulk, Current Assessment Item** – Medication Bulk, Current has been added to the Assessment Item Configuration Library. It will pull any medication that is entered as Bulk Supply.
