

Pneumococcal Vaccination Tip Sheet

- Pneumococcal patient vaccination at NKC will consist of 20-Valent Pneumococcal Conjugate Vaccine (PCV20).
- For each dose give PCV20 0.5 ml intramuscularly (preferably in the deltoid muscle).
- Determine the patient's prior pneumococcal vaccination history and vaccinate with PCV 20 as follows:
 - 1) If patient has never received pneumonia vaccination, or does not remember having the vaccine:
 - a. Give PCV20
 - b. Stop vaccinations
 - 2) If patient has received PPSV23 only at any age
 - a. Wait for at least 1 year after PPSV23
 - b. Give PCV20
 - c. Stop vaccinations
 - 3) If patient has received PCV13 only at any age
 - a. Wait for at least 1 year after PCV13
 - b. Give PCV20
 - c. Stop vaccinations
 - 4) If patient has received PCV 13 at any age and PPSV 23 at less than 65 years
 - b. Wait for at least 5 years after PPSV 23
 - c. Give PCV 20
 - d. Stop vaccinations
 - 5) If patient previously received PCV13 and PPSV23 and one of the doses of PPSV23 was administered when the patient was 65 years or older, no further pneumococcal vaccinations are required.

*Note: PCV 20 may be administered to these patients depending on patient and provider preference. Contact patient's nephrologist to determine if PCV 20 administration is advised. If so, wait at least 5 years from the last pneumococcal vaccination, administer PCV 20 and stop vaccinations.
