

Clarity Monthly Update May 2023

General Information

Visonex regularly updates Clarity with fixes to issues reported and enhancements based on user feedback. The following is a general overview of those fixes and enhancements that will occur on Monday, May 8, 2023.

What's Fixed in Clarity

1. Patient Chart View

• The link to the General Information form in the Registration tab is fixed.

2. Visit Management

• The copy of Visit Management in Patient>Notes displayed the access as a number. The access will now display as a description.

3. Real-Time Charting Post

 With some facilities, when reviewing past treatments, the dry weight was pulling from the current dialysis prescription and not the one used for that treatment date.

4. General Information Screen Updates

- It is now possible to right-click your mouse to cut or copy or paste in this screen.
- The Transient Information Address fields can now hold more than 1000 characters.
- The validation for the Medical Beneficiary Identifier (MBI) had been removed but is now fixed. If a wrong pattern of letters and digits are entered in the MBI field, submitting the entry will result in an error message:

Invalid format in field Medicare Beneficiary Identifier . Does not fit expected format: ********* (Click to fix the error.)

- Leaving the Mobile Phone number field blank will no longer trigger an error message.
- Visonex has fixed the issue where the Clarity ID was not populating in the General Information screen when adding a patient and saving.
- Visonex has fixed the issue where the CrownWeb IDNumber field could not be updated.
- Visonex resolved an issue where edits on random patients did not save when submitted.



5. Patient Billing Worksheet Expanded Report

• If the primary insurance company was ended during the date range it would not appear in the report. Now, the primary insurance company will appear if active during the date range selected.

6. Untranscribed Orders Library Item

There is a new checklist library item: Untranscribed Orders – Last N Days.
By default, it will display any untranscribed orders from the last 30 days.

What's New in Clarity

1. Patient Chart View Search Options

• In addition to searching by patient name, it is now possible to search by Patient MRN or Patient Dialysis ID.

2. Reports

New vs. Old Reports

Reports are in the process of being upgraded. Upgraded reports will have Output Types that are limited to PDF or Viewer. To select output types other than PDF (e.g., Excel), select Viewer, click Run Report, then click the output type at the top of the report display.



• Missing Patient Data Report

This report now includes Patient Ethnicity from the General Information form.

3. Pre-dialysis Information (2728)

 For CEHRT Certification, clicking on the blue question mark icon in the Co-Morbid Conditions section will display Tips and Tricks.
