

New employee e-learning tool launching in July

Northwest Kidney Centers ' will be launching a new e-learning tool called MedTrainer in late July. This will replace Relias, offering access to more trainings /accreditations and easier navigation . MedTrainer will still be accessed via KNET and will have a dedicated resource page on K-Net as well. Staff will still be able to use Relias until the launch of MedTrainer on July 22nd. Q: I have some confidential NKC documents that I would like to work on using a program I have on my home computer . Am I allowed to email those to my personal email ?

A: No. Workforce members are not allowed to forward NKC email to a third -party email address, including their personal email, or to save email on external servers such as Google, Yahoo, Hotmail, Dropbox, Comcast, etc. All NKC confidential information is the property of NKC, and all employees are expected to safeguard that confidentiality.

Palliative Care team celebrates collaborative success

The palliative care team is incredibly grateful for all of the collaboration from NKC unit staff in supporting our patients together. Since January, you all have sent 53 new referrals our way and we've had a chance to meet 40 new patients. We've had social workers and nursing staff from Burien, Enumclaw, Snoqualmie Ridge, Seattle, and Broadway join us in family meetings. We have seen the positive impact of this collaboration not only on our patients ' care but also on our NKC team. Supporting each other through unique and challenging patient care situations helps alleviate moral distress. We have been able to help 11 people access hospice WITH dialysis to provide optimal symptom management and peace of mind at the end of their lives. Thanks to support from leadership and development, the addition of a coordinator on our team enabled us to eliminate the wait time for patients to meet us.

Our goals for the coming year are to join more of you in your IPT meetings so you can get to know us better and have informal discussions about our shared patients. We are also using data of race/ethnicity, number of visits, and rates of hospice utilization to interrogate the equity of our service and learn how we can continue to improve our care.

Help Dads eat healthy and stay happy this Father's Day. If meat is his preference, try more fish and less red meat. Include a healthy salad. Below are quick salmon and salad recipes for this weekend.

Herb Crusted Salmon (from Favorite Family Recipes)

1 large salmon filet

1 bottle of Dijon mustard or 1 cup

2 cups chopped herbs, for example : cilantro, basil, parsley, rosemary

Remove stems from herbs and chop. Slather salmon with mustard and cover with herbs. Cook at 325 for 20 minutes or until done. Serve with lemon.

Lemon Orzo (from A Couple Cooks)

1 cup orzo (small pasta) per 8 cups of boiling water, cook 8 minutes or until tender. Add salt, lemon juice, a little olive oil (or butter) and a sprinkle of fresh parsley. Stir and serve warm. (Optional : add in parmesan cheese or feta cheese)
