General Information

Renvio regularly updates Clarity with fixes to issues reported and enhancements based on user feedback. The following is a general overview of those fixes and enhancements that will be released on Sunday, September 8, 2024. You will see these updates starting Monday, September 9.

What's New in Clarity

1. Dialysis Access

- 'Angiogram' has been added to the Exam/Procedure dropdown
- 'Regained Function' has been added to the Reason Removed dropdown

2. RTC Medications

• Bulk Supply medications will now display with the prescription dose and form.

3. PCV Microbiology folder

 Currently, culture and sensitivity results are available through the <u>Patient</u> <u>Microbiology Detail Report</u> link in the Patient Infection sub-menu or by running the Microbiology Detail patient report in Report Wizard. We will soon also be able view these as a sub-section in the Patient Chart View Lab results tab. Watch for an email with more information.



4. 2746 Death Information

- In Primary Cause of Death and Secondary Cause(s) of Death dropdowns:
 - i. 'INFECTION-COVID19' has been changed to 'OTHER COVID-19'
 - ii. 'OTHER Severe adverse medication reaction' has been added

5. Transplant Waitlist Report

- Data sources are as follows:
 - i. Registration>General Information
 - ii. Registration>Patient Status History
 - iii. Registration>Patient's Nursing Home
 - iv. Registration>Transplant Management>Transplant Waitlist Form

6. Dialysis Prescription

- For Patients who have >3x/Wk dialysis previously required a second prescription to display the ICD-10 code for the justification of the 4^{th} through 7^{th} treatments.
- Staff can now associate two justifications in the Hemodialysis Prescriptions by clicking on **Add Multiple ICD-10**:

What's Fixed in Clarity

•

1. Unstable CIA incorrectly updating to Stable

• An issue where if a patient was unstable and remained so after the CIA was completed, their status was incorrectly updated to stable. Now, the patient will continue to be marked as unstable unless it is documented that their condition has stabilized.

2. Submenu disappearing while in Immunizations

• If a user was in Patient>Immunizations and went to another main menu, then a selected submenu would disappear. This is fixed.

3. RTC Treatment Tab UFR>999

• Validation has been added to prevent a value greater than 999 to be entered in RTC Treatment Tab UFR.

4. Report Wizard Blank Page

• A bug in which running a report in Report Wizard would result in a blank page has been fixed.
