300+ patients

The clinic's 46 dialysis stations will have the capacity to provide in-center dialysis treatment to more than 300 patients.

Home patient support

The clinic's nine home dialysis training rooms will provide training and monthly support for 125 patients who dialyze at home.

One-of-a-kind care

Northwest Kidney Centers patients have access to our embedded Palliative Care program, specialized pharmacy services and on-site clinical trials with the University of Washington.

Community education

The clinic will have dedicated space for chronic kidney disease classes for patients and their families.
