Flu campaign starting in October

### Fully subsidized ORCA cards now available for all employees

Starting October 1st, Northwest Kidney Centers will fully cover the cost of monthly ORCA cards for all employees who plan to use public transportation to commute to work 10 or more days a month. With this this enhanced benefit, we encourage more staff to explore alternative methods to commute to work.

#### Mandatory training for new ADP Time and Attendance

Beginning Oct. 13, staff will start using ADP Time and Attendance for timekeeping. All staff are required to attend one of the three following training sessions :

- Sept. 26, 2:30-3:30 p.m. PST
- Oct. 7, 3:30-4:30 p.m. PST
- Oct. 8, 8:00-9:00 a.m. PST

Trainings will be recorded and made available for those who cannot attend in person.

As part of the ongoing review of our systems and services, we will close the KConnect Wi-Fi and ask those using KConnect to start using KGuest. We are closing KConnect by October 31st.

### Compliance Q&A

Q: Can you please send a reminder about when I should report compliance or privacy issues and how to make a report ? A: All NKC employees who encounter what they believe is noncompliant behavior or a privacy issue, must report that conduct. You do not have to personally witness the behavior. If you have a good faith belief that it happened, you are required to make a report. Here are several ways you can file a report \*:

- 1. Via your supervisor or manager
- 2. Via the 24/7 Anonymous Compliance Hotline : 1-800-371-2174
- 3. Via the Compliance & Privacy Button in the SAS System
- 4. Via the links on the K-Net Compliance tab
- 5. Via email at Compliance @nwkidney .org (mailto:Compliance @nwkidney.org) or PrivacyOfficer @nwkidney .org (mailto:PrivacyOfficer @nwkidney.org)
- 6. Via paper forms which can be found at each clinic location .

### Clarity MFA will be launching on Oct. 28th

Beginning October 28th, all staff members using Clarity will be required to set up Multi - Factor Authentication (MFA). This will require the download of either the Google or Microsoft Authenticator app and you may want to do that ahead of time. Staff who currently use the authenticator app for Outlook do not have redownload as that app will work to authenticate Clarity. Additional information will be provided as the launch date approaches.
