

New Employee Orientation revamp now live

We're rolling out some big changes to our New Employee Orientation (NEO) to make it an even better experience for new hires! Starting this month, new employees' first day will run from 9 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. (they'll still be paid for a full 8-hour workday).

We've also refreshed some of the presentations and added a short tour of our dialysis museum to the NEO schedule. After the NEO session ends, managers will connect with their new employees, either in person or virtually. This quick check-in helps reinforce what new hires learned during the day, provides a personal welcome to the team, and gives employees a chance to ask any questions. The People team will send leaders guidelines on how to make the most of this important moment.

Time to review your ADP information

As we kick off the new year, it's a good opportunity to take a few moments to review your personal information in ADP and make sure everything is up-to-date. Here are a few things to double-check:

Health plan benefits

• Did everything look correct during open enrollment? Log into ADP and click on *Benefits* to review your selections and confirm they're accurate.

Beneficiary information

• Is your beneficiary information current? It's always a good idea to make sure this is updated, especially if you've had any significant life changes like getting married or having a baby.

401(k) contributions

• Review your savings goals. Take a look at your 401(k) contributions and consider if you'd like to make adjustments. Log into your account at <u>Empower</u> to update your contributions.

Tax withholding

• Tax season will be here before we know it! Now is a good time to review your tax withholding in ADP to avoid any surprises come April.

Address update

• Have you moved recently? Make sure your address is up to date in ADP so that important documents, like tax forms, reach you without any issues.
