Quick Procedure Reminders

1. Needle Site Preparation

Clean each cannulation site with an alcohol pad for 30 seconds using a circular motion. Repeat with a second alcohol pad and cannulate while the site is still wet.

2. Cleaning Blood Spills

Immediately wipe all visible blood using disposable absorbent pads or disinfectant wipes and discard materials in the infectious waste container. Re-clean the area with fresh disinfectant wipes, ensuring proper contact time. Wear full PPE throughout the process, dispose of gloves in the infectious waste bin, and finish with handwashing using soap and water.
