

Clarity Monthly Update

December 2020

General Information

On the 3rd Sunday of every month, Visonex usually updates Clarity with fixes to issues reported and enhancements based on client feedback. The following is a general overview of those fixes and enhancements that occurred on December 13, 2020.

What's Fixed in Clarity

1. **Patient Labels and Information Labels now work with PDF.** The Clinic Report, "Patient Labels," and the Patient Report, "Information Labels," have been upgraded to be able to print using PDF. Previously, these reports did not properly align onto the labels.
2. **Patients on Medications Groups report has been upgraded.** This report has been updated to a new framework.
3. **Outpatient Dialysis Prescription: Not Saving Two Fields.** Prior to the fix, Sodium Profile and Dialysate Temp were not saving in the Dialysis Prescription.
4. **Fixed Dialysis Prescription report for Unselected "Sodium Profile" Value.** Prior to the fix, if a Sodium Profile was not selected in the Dialysis Prescription, the patient's prescription would not display on the Dialysis Prescription report.
5. **Daily Unentered Treatments report.** This report has been updated for better performance.
6. **Patient Identifier History Page.** When going to Registration>Patient Identifier History, the page was displaying an error. This has now been resolved.
7. **Update Order Methods will be Hidden.** There was a bug causing "Rescheduled" to appear in the Order Method. This has now been resolved.
8. **Fixed Primary Nurse on the Patient Care Team Grid.** Unchecking the Primary Nurse box will now remove the Primary flag in the display grid with allows you to keep the nurse on the care team if you wish. The patient should have a new nurse designated as the Primary Nurse, though.

9. **Patient Chart View; NxStage Prescription display update.** The NxStage Prescription in Patient Chart View will now display the SAK and Bag information from the Dialysis Prescription form.
10. **Patient Chart View; Immunizations Tab Display Update.** In the Immunization Tab in Patient Chart View, you no longer need to click Search to have the immunizations display.
11. **DataXpress-Sensipar Totaling Issues.** Visonex fixed an issue regarding the Sensipar dose appearing with one dose less than expected.

What's New in Clarity

1. **Medication Order Form: Changed wording of "ESRD Related" to "Related to ESRD or AKI."**
 - a. On the Patient Medication form, Visonex updated the wording/label of "ESRD Related" to "Related to ESRD or AKI."

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- b. Users should only check medications as "No" and apply the AY modifier to separate reimbursement for the medication if the medication is not being administered in *relation to dialysis*. AKI items and services fall under ESRD PPS bundle and do not get separate reimbursement.
 - c. Example: If Vancomycin is being administered for an infection that is not related to a dialysis access, the user could select "No" but an appropriate ICD 10 would need to be associated as the justification. An ICD 10 should always be entered for the justification, but it should not be added to the Patient Problem List by a nurse.
2. **Add/Edit Labs-Upgrade from Asp to MVC.** The Laboratories>Add/Edit Labs form has been changed to a new framework.
3. **New Clinic Report: Patient by Modality.** A new Clinic Report "Patients by Modality" has been created by Visonex which is date selectable. You can review patient modalities and identify any that need to be corrected.
