General Information

Visonex regularly updates Clarity with fixes to issues reported and enhancements based on user feedback. The following is a general overview of those fixes and enhancements that will be released on Sunday, March 10, 2024.

What's New in Clarity

1. Real-Time Charting

- **Required Items** that must be populated in order to post an RTC now have asterisks (*).
- *The Medications/Imn tab will not display asterisks but will continue to have to be completed in order to post the treatment.*

3. Kidney Disease and Quality of Life (KDQOL-36) Assessment

- The Kidney Disease and Quality of Life (KDQOL – 36) patient assessment now has a Complete button for use when finished. It will allow for better tracking of KDQOL in QMAT.

4. Reports

- Hemodialysis Setup Information** Report – will now include the patient's code status and nephrologist name.
- Plans of Care** Report - The Plans of Care Report has been upgraded to a Patient report instead of a Clinic report. This will now allow clinics to have a link to the Plan of Cares report from your RIA or CIA. Clinics can still run the report for all patients in Advanced mode.
- Microbiology Detail** Patient Report – will now display the most recent Completed Date first.
- Billing Worksheet Expanded**– had some medication names that had apostrophes. This is fixed.
- Reports Date Range** – Reports that looked at CST time zone in date range instead of clinic time zone has been fixed.

5. Social Drivers of Health Library

- Two new library sections related to SDOH reporting are now available for addition to patient assessments. Reporting will be required beginning January 2025.
- Social Drivers Required will pull in questions 1-10 from the AHC HRSN Screen Tool Questions and Social Drivers – Optional that will pull in questions 11-26. Please contact support services if you would like the section added to a current assessment. Please submit a request to the IT ServiceDesk to have these added to any assessment
- Attestations could have been completed in Jan 2024 based on current CIA structure. This is to assure that information is being collected in a standardized format for future potential regulatory submission requirement.

What's Fixed in Clarity

1. Required immunizations scheduled after RTC opened

- If an immunization is scheduled for today's treatment after the RTC was opened and the medication tab was documented, the treatment could be posted without documenting new immunization. The user will no longer be able to post without first documenting the new immunization.

2. Treatment tab Conductivity display

- The conductivity label in RTC>Treatment tab detail was corrected to $\mu\text{S}/\text{cm}$.

3. Hospitals

- The Hospital dropdown list in Hospitalizations & Consultations is now in alphabetical order again.

4. 2728 Cause of Renal Failure Date

- An issue in Registration>Pre-Dialysis 2728 form in which the ICD10 code list was not updating for patients who started dialysis prior to 2015 has been fixed.

5. Unable to open Patient Assessments

- An issue where certain Patient Assessments could not be opened due to access settings has been permanently fixed.

6. Time Zone

- An issue in which some reports pulled data based on Central Standard Time instead of Pacific Standard Time is resolved.

7. Ascend Outbound Treatment Time for Kt/V

- Treatment duration data needed for Ascend Kt/V calculation was not being sent to Ascend if there was not Prescribed Treatment time. Total Treatment Time from the RTC post dialysis is now being sent effective 2/21/2024.
